
HANGING 2D WORK



TOOLS:

- Tape Measure
- Pencil & Painters Tape
- Scratch Pad/Paper
- Level
- Hammer
- Proper Hardware

TAKE MEASUREMENTS:

- A. Total HEIGHT
- **B.** Divide by 2 to get CENTER of ARTWORK
- C. BOTTOM of TOP of D-RING to TOP of ARTWORK
- **D.** CENTER of D-RING to CENTER of D-RING
- **E.** SIDE of ARTWORK to CENTER of D-RING
- Wash hands and/or wear gloves when handling ARTWORK.
- Carefully place ARTWORK against wall (FACE IN); add protective layer between wall and ARTWORK.
- Decide the CENTER point for the piece. We typically hang ARTWORK at a midpoint of 56-62 inches (CENTER of piece on the wall measured from the floor).
- MARK w/ tape horizontal location on wall. Work LEFT RIGHT, or vice versa. (If you MARK RIGHT side of where ARTWORK goes on wall, then work LEFT RIGHT on BACK of ARTWORK).
- SUBTRACT (C.) from (B.); then ADD your CENTER measurement:
 eg. (C.) = 10; (B.) = 15; CENTER = 60 in. | 10 15 = 5 + 60 = 65 in.
 65 in. (from the floor) is where the TOP of your first D-RING will be placed on the wall.
- LOCATE horizontal MARK for D-RINGS: From tape on wall, MARK measurement of FRAME to CENTER of D-RING (E.). Match up with HEIGHT measurement. MARK a small "X" on wall. This is location for RIGHT D-RING (or LEFT when working from back of ARTWORK).
- From this MARK add measurement from D-RING to D-RING (**D.**) to LEFT of current MARK. Match up horizontal measurements with LEVEL; DO NOT measure from floor.
- Carefully HANG ARTWORK on wall. Carefully place a LEVEL on TOP of ARTWORK to check LEVEL.
 Make adjustments as necessary.
