

A is for Albescent.  
As in becoming white.  
Point of origin unknown.

B is for Blanche.  
As in Carte. As in white paper.  
As in “full discretionary power, unrestricted permission or authority in some manner.”  
As in “paper duly authenticated by a signature and otherwise blank, left to someone to be filled in at his discretion.”

C is for Cracker.  
As in hard wafer. As in coal-cracker.  
As in “They are small, gaunt, and cadaverous, and their skin is just the color of the sand-hills they live on. They are quite incapable of applying themselves steadily to any labor, and their habits are very much like those of the old Indians.” [Frederick Law Olmsted, “A Journey in the Seaboard Slave States,” 1856]

D is for Dwarf.  
As in a star’s luminosity, highest and lowest.  
As in a small, very dense star.

E is for Eggshell, edelweiss.  
As in paint color, treading carefully, thin and delicate.  
As in nobility.

F is for Flag.  
As in surrender.  
As in truce. As in cease.

G is for Glair.  
As in part of an egg.  
As in bright, clear. As in healthy, clean, light.

H is for House.  
As in 1600 Pennsylvania Ave.  
As in residence and workplace.  
As in work-life balance.

I is for Irreproachable.  
As in lily-white.  
As in apart, alone, unrivaled, peerless, isolated.  
As in whites-only.

J is for Jeff.

As in brevity.

As in "sometimes used by African-Americans to indicate a Southern rural poor white person."

K is for Kir.

As in a drink made of wine and creme de cassis.

As in a recipe. As in invention.

L is for Liebfraumlch.

As in German wine.

As in "milk of Our Lady."

M is for Mameluke.

As in "source of Portuguese *Mameluco* (n.) 'mestizo, cross-breed between a white and a native Brazilian.'"

As in "Egyptian dynasty 1254-1517, originally a military unit comprised of Caucasian slaves."

N is for nigra.

As in "a white Southern U.S. pronunciation."

As in derogatory compromise.

As in slang.

O is for Ofay.

As in African American word for white person.

As in "Yoruba *ofe* 'to disappear' (as from a powerful enemy), with the sense transferred from the word of self-protection to the source of the threat."

P is for Poor.

As in po' white trash.

As in "To the Southerner, the 'poor white' in the strictest sense is a being beyond the pale of even the most generous democratic recognition...so much social debris." [Robert Penn Warren, "The Briar Patch, 1930, footnote].

Q is for Quadroon, Queen Anne.

As in offspring.

As in "feathery blossom."

R is for Russian.

As in mixed drink.

As in "the rug really tied the room together."

S is for Supremacy.

As in "being third in descent from a Negro."

As in the Spanish "*terceron*, from *tercero*, a third (person).
